



The ancient via Emilia of the Romans ran exactly where the present road is, along the axis of viale Roma. For about 2,200 years that road has been in exactly the same spot.




# EMILIA VIA TOUR OF INFRASTRUCTURE WEB


B1\_\_


B4\_\_


B5\_\_


B8\_\_


B3\_\_
